I created a manual of 12 lessons which we are currently studying, titled "Planted By the Water," I finished a devotional practice of 50 days of prayer, and I am working on the next series of sermons on "The Parables of Jesus." God is good, all the time.

This month I restarted classes in seminary, teaching two subjects: "Acts of the Apostles" and "Missionary Conscience"
