from the sierra of Veracruz, to the east of Mexico, He speaks the Nahuatl dialect. With the little Spanish that we have managed to communicate, he asked me if I could ask God for his health since for some months he loses consciousness and does not know where he is or who he is, after a while remember everything but is very tired. We prayed for healing. We stopped seeing him almost all November until last Sunday when he returned with a different face and with more confidence and came to me and told me that God had healed him and that he wanted to know more about Christ. I thank God for Ricardo, our new brother in Christ, who with a big smile and a good handshake said goodbye to me.

They invited Mimi and me to share in the School of Ministries of the church Promised Land in Atizapán, north of the city, with pastors Bob Stevenson and his wife.
