

Covid Safety Guidelines for Salford Sunday School Fall 2021 (updated 9/9/21)

Our first choice for Sunday School in fall 2021 (Sept-Nov) will be outdoors. After that time, this plan will be re-evaluated.

In accordance with the latest Montgomery county guidance, masks are required for all participants indoors, and also outdoors (when not 6' apart and not exerting).

Upon arrival participants (kids and adults) must verify the following:

- No positive COVID test in the past 10 days or contact with anyone with a + test in the past 14 days
- No COVID symptoms for the past 10 days (fever, shaking, chills, sore throat, difficulty breathing, unexplained muscle aches, new cough, loss of smell or taste), unless the person has tested negative for COVID since onset

We won't be taking temperatures; please do that at home. Our expectation is that adult volunteers will be vaccinated against COVID-19

Masks, Distancing, and Food/Drinks:

- Masks will be worn at all times, by kids and volunteers, unless participants are 6'+ apart
- When snacks are provided, hand sanitizer will be provided before and after snack time
- Participants should bring their own beach towel to sit on and water bottle
- When singing and snack happen indoors, participants will be spaced apart

Inclement Weather

In case of inclement weather, we will meet indoors in the classrooms downstairs. Families will be notified that morning prior to the start of worship.
