Do you remember Arturo?, an 11-year-old boy who we prayed for his health, stomach cancer, because they have only sent him check-ups every 6 months because the cancer has been encapsulated and diminished, glory to God!

The constant testimonies there are from; neighbors killed, shot, put in prison, beaten women, etc.

Pray a lot for us and this mission. God watch over us, guide us and use us to spread his kingdom here.
