Path Forward Design Team Update; Additional Discernment Opportunity

This week we all take a well-earned break from our work of discernment during second hour. We will have two more meetings during the first two Sundays in November.

Not everyone who has wanted to be part of the conversation has been able to join us around the fellowship hall tables each week. For that reason, we're having a special session on Sunday at 6:30 p.m. in the fellowship hall. This session is for three types of people: 1.) those who have been teaching Sunday school during second hour, 2.) those who have had to be away, or to work, or for some reason have been unable to be present, and 3.) those who simply feel they would benefit by some more conversation and time for questions.

If you come on Sunday evening, take some time first to review the recordings of the sessions that are on our church website on the Path Forward webpage.

Take notes if you feel that would help you remember content or frame questions. During the meeting, we will take a few minutes to review the content and note the scripture passages we've been studying. Following that, there will be open time for questions, observations about the texts and time for reflection.

Some of you have remarked that it has felt like we have moved through each week's material very quickly. Maybe this will help us slow down and take in more than we were able to receive the first time.

Finance Update for Salford Mennonite Church

For the remainder of 2022, we will present a weekly update of our financial situation.

- We have advised our Staff team and Ministry teams to be conservative with spending for the remainder of the year. No new spending initiatives for this year.
- We will need \$234,000 in offering and income for the last nine weeks of 2022 to cover our expected expenses.
- We will need an average of \$15,500 in weekly offering in October and November and an average of \$36,000 in weekly offering in December. This is a **18%** increase from last year.
- Average weekly offering needed for October and November: \$15,500
- Average weekly offering received so far for October and November (4 weeks): \$12,673

Donations can be placed on the donation of the month table by the infant nursery in the main fover.




Here is a sampling of new materials:

Eleven-year-old Melody is not like most people. She can't walk. She can't talk. She can't write. All because she has cerebral palsy. Most people—her teachers, her doctors, her classmates—dismiss her as mentally challenged because she can't tell them otherwise. But Melody refuses to be defined by her disability.
